My vehicle is a 2006 Ford F-150 with the Lariat trim package. This is a terrific truck for a family, as it seats five very comfortably. It is very roomy, and the leather interior makes long trips very pleasurable. It is loaded with features like power windows, mirrors, and door locks, heated seats, and a power rear sliding window.

Although the new Coyote engine had increased displacement, it still had far fewer cubes than the competition. Despite less displacement, the Coyote could hold its own against bigger Chevy and Chrysler mills thanks to advanced technology such as 4V heads with better port and valvetrain geometry. The Coyote is also Ford's first foray into technology such as Ti-VCT and cam-torque-actuated (CTA) function, which is a fancy way of saying variable cam timing for an incredible power curve over a broader RPM range. Even with all of this new technology, there is always room for improvement, and both Ford and the aftermarket have produced an array of parts to squeeze even more power out of your Coyote.
